1. UNIVERSAL RECOGNITION

The Club at Nevillewood is considered one of the finest clubs in the Pittsburgh market. Received Distinguished Club designation from Board Room Magazine.

2. EXCELLENCE IN AMENITIES AND FACILITIES

The Club completed an \$8.3 million renovation of the clubhouse facilities in 2020. The project included an expanded and upgraded casual dining room and patio, a new Golf Shoppe, addition of a new Golf Operations building for cart and bag storage, a golf simulator, new pool bar and grille with upgraded and expanded pool deck, and the addition of a world class fitness center. Plans are currently underway (vote to be held 8/16/22) for a \$2.6 million renovation of the club's second floor (Mixed Grille and private dining) and third floor (ballroom).

3. CALIBER OF STAFF AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICE LEVELS

The Club at Nevillewood has a mix of long term professionals and newer professional staff. GM / COO Dick Naumann, CCM, CCE has been in club management for 33 years managing the following Platinum Clubs: Oak Hill CC, Aronimink GC, and Jonathan's Landing GC. Dick has been honored as Club Manger of the Year in the Western / Central New York State and Philadelphia and Vicinity chapters of CMAA.

Superintendent Ken Flisek has been with Nevillewood for 32 years working with Jack Nicklaus to complete and grow in the course in 1991. Ken is very active with GCSAA and the West Penn Golf Association. Director of Golf Jim Antkiewicz recently retired after 26 years at the club. During that time, Jim served on the National Board of the PGA and was awarded the PGA National Professional of the Year. Cory Livingston, a 12 year Assistant Pro was promoted to replace Jim. Controller Jake Smith, active with HTPF, has been with the club for over 20 years.

4. ENGAGEMENT AND COMMITMENT OF MEMBERSHIP

Club members are engaged in committees to provide member feedback and facilitate communication back to the general members in House, Golf, Grounds, Finance, and Membership, Pool & Fitness, and Long Range Planning.

5. GOVERNANCE AND PRUDENT FISCAL MANAGEMENT

The nine-member Board of Directors focuses on long-term strategic direction and supports the GM as COO concept leaving operational management to the professional staff. The Club is engaged with Club Benchmarking for industry benchmarks and falls in the yellow-to green bucket range. The Club has established a waitlist for full golf and has created a capital reserve account for future use.

6. ADAPTING TO CHANGING TIMES

The recent renovation was focused on providing upgrading casual dining and pool facilities in addition to adding the best private club fitness center in the region. The result has been the addition of over 200 new members in the last two years, many being younger families. The planned renovations will upgrade our more upscale member dining room and update the ballroom.

7. OVERALL EXPERIENCE

The Club at Nevillewood provides the membership a Jack Nicklaus Signature course considered to be one of the best designed and maintained courses in the region. The clubhouse facilities provide a casual elegance for the members to enjoy both traditional and family friendly social programming.
